

# **About Open Science Cafés**

Open Science Cafés are online webinars that combine discussions known as "World Café" discussions with training workshops. These Open Science Cafés are part of the training provided by UC3M and are open to all teaching and research staff (PDI) and interested researchers (particularly our YUFE colleagues), as well as doctoral students, as part of their specific cross-disciplinary training in Open Science (UC3MTicket2OS).

Each Open Science Café will be a virtual session focusing on a key aspect of Open Science that will be discussed during that session. Each session will last approximately 1 hour and will include a 30-minute presentation by an expert in the field, followed by a 30-minute discussion (which may range from Q&A to co-creative activities). All webinars/workshops will be conducted in English at 3:00 PM. CEST, as per the proposed schedule. You can register for 1, 2, etc. seminars for free. To be eligible for a certificate of training from Human Resources, you need to attend at least 4 out of the 7 Open Science Cafés.
